
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#### **OVERVIEW OF VIETNAM'S FISHERIES**




- Vietnam has a coastline of 3,260 km long and an Exclusive Economic Zone of over 1 million km<sup>2</sup> and more than 4,000 islands and archipelagos; a dense system of rivers and lakes.
- Vietnam is a country with a relatively large number of fishing vessels in Southeast Asia (2023: 86,000 vessels)
- Diverse types of ecosystems: freshwater, brackish water, saltwater; industrial aquaculture, marine aquaculture and reservoir aquaculture.
- Seafood trade: domestic consumption and export.

#### 1.1. Fisheries Production of Vietnam

#### Fisheries production of Vietnam (million MT)



- In 2023: Total fisheries production: 9.3 million MT

Aquaculture: 5.45 million tons; Capture: 3.85 million tons.


- 2004-2023:aquaculture/fisheries ratio increasing

Aqua. production (56-58%) Cap. Fisheries (42-44%)

Average growth rate: 3-4.5%/year.

#### 1.2. Fisheries Export Revenue




- Fisheries export turnover in 2023: 9.2 billion USD. In there:
- + Pangasius: 2.35 billion USD,
- + Shrimp: 4.2 billion USD,
- + Seafood: 2 billion USD and other objects 0,65 billion USD.
- Vietnamese seafood has been exported to more than 170 countries and territories.
- Some major seafood import markets from Vietnam are: EU, US, Korea, China,...

#### **Export turn over value:**

2023: 9.2 Billion USD, (-) 17,8% YoY


First 8 months of 2024: 6.3 billion USD, (+) 9% YoY

-Pangasius and shrimp account for more than 70% of the export market share

#### **Markets - Distributions**

- □ Shrimp, Pangasius: Major commodity,
- □ Red Tilapia, black tilapia:
- Frozen whole fish, fillet
- Domestic consumption is tending to increase faster than exports
- ☐ Frog and snake head fish:Cambodia market
- □ 5 major markets: US, EU,
  □ Japan, Korea, China

### 2. SSF, Women and Youth in Fisheries and Aquaculture

- Total number of workers in the fisheries industry is about 5 million workers. Of which:
- Fishing: About 600,000 fishermen working on fishing boats (mainly man and young people).
- Aquaculture and logistics services, trade: 4,400,000 people
- In general, female are major work in seafood processing factories and fishery service areas.
- It is hard to work in fisheries industry, so most of the workers are young.



## 3. Production, Distribution and Trade – Challenges, Bottlenecks and Barriers

- The large number of fishing vessels, especially small fishing vessels operating inshore.
- Many small-scale, household aquaculture models are difficult to manage and develop on a commercial scale.
- The education and awareness of fishermen and aquaculture farmers are still low, limiting the application of new technology.
- Barriers on anti-dumping taxes, protection policies, technical barriers, health certification or traceability of fisheries products are challenges for Vietnam's fisheries industry.
- Requirement from export markets: registration, health certification, low CO2 emission, animal welfare...





### 4. Additional Information

- Vietnam has issued the Strategy for Vietnam's Fisheries Development to 2030, with a vision to 2045 (Decision No. 339/QD-TTg), with the goal of: "Developing fisheries into an important economic sector of the country, producing large-scale of goods associated with industrialization modernization, sustainable development and proactive adaptation to climate change; having a reasonable structure and form of production organization, high productivity, quality and efficiency; having a prestigious brand, competitiveness and international integration; constantly improving the material and spiritual life of the people, ensuring social security; .."
- This will be an important orientation for Vietnam to develop the fisheries industry now and in the future.
